BOOKS BY MAIL @ YOUR LIBRARY

Largo, MD – Finding it harder to get to your local library? We can help. Books by Mail grants access to your Prince George's County Memorial Library System at home. County residents who are age 75 and up or those homebound-certified are eligible to borrow and return library books, audio books and magazines through the mail.

Seniors, age 75 and up, automatically qualify for the Books by Mail library service and may opt in at any time. Start requesting materials today through the library's online catalog, using your library card number and password. Search for your desired title, click on *Place Request* next to the selected item, check the *Please mail this to me box* and click on *Submit Request*. Need assistance? Visual impaired, physically disabled, in a residential care facility or retirement home, this service is for you too! Complete the Books by Mail application on our website at www.pgcmlls.info and have it certified by one of the following: health care provider, caregiver or clergy. Drop off your completed application at any of our branch library locations or mail it to Outreach Services, Prince George's County Memorial Library System, 9601 Capital Lane, Largo, MD 20774. The application turnaround time is about a week.

It's in the bag! A mail bag with your library materials will be delivered as requested. When you are finished with the materials, flip the address label over on the mail bag. It will have our address with prepaid postage. Return the borrowed items in the mail bag. Please allow time for the materials to reach the Library by the due date. Materials will be automatically renewed if there is no request pending. The Library is committed to assisting all our County residents. We encourage all qualified customers to take advantage of this free service.
