English for Refugees and Asylees (ERA)

Who is eligible? Any refugee, SIV, or asylee who has been granted status within the last five years, and is living in Maryland.

What documents do I need to register?

1. Proof of status, such as work authorization card, I-94, etc., and
2. Proof of residency, such as a utility bill or a lease agreement

To prepare for registration, provide required documents and your updated phone number to Lailuma Social via email at sociallx@pgcc.edu.

On registration dates: We will call you to check your information in your native language and test your level through a few questions in English.
