


Community Raving About Books (C.R.A.B.) Book Club Guide

Margaret Atwood, whose work has been published in thirty-five countries, is the author of more than forty books of fiction, poetry, and critical essays. Her novel *The Blind Assassin* won the 2000 Booker Prize. She is the recipient of the Los Angeles Times Innovator's Award, and lives in Toronto with the writer Graeme Gibson.
